



Q2 Do you rent or own the place where you live?





Q3 Length of time at current address?



Q4 What year was your home built?





Q6 How many people reside at this home year-round?





Q8 What is the highest level of education you have completed?










Q9 For each statement below, how strongly do you believe it IS or IS NOT anenvironmental concern in Santa Fe?













Q14 Which reason(s) support the conservation steps you take sometimes or all of the time? (check all that apply)







Q16 During a drought, do you change your water use behavior and why?





Q18 Is recycled water used in Santa Fe?



Q19 As choices for new sources of water continue to decrease, what is your opinion about using recycled and treated water for drinking purposes?


